



COVERAGE START DATES FOR NEW ENROLLEES:

COVERAGE TYPE	WHEN DOES IT START?
<p>Provisional MassHealth Coverage</p>	<p>Children, adults younger than 21, and pregnant women:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Coverage starts 10 days before the date that the application is received by MassHealth. <p>All other individuals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Coverage starts after income verifications have been received. <p>If "all other individuals" send in verification <u>during provisional period(90 days):</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Final coverage determination goes back 10 days from the date that the application was received by MassHealth. <p>If "all other individuals" send in verification <u>after the provisional period ends:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Final coverage determination goes back 10 days from when verifications were received by MassHealth.
<p>MassHealth Standard</p>	<p>Coverage starts 10 days before the date the application is received by MassHealth.</p>
<p>MassHealth CarePlus</p>	<p>Coverage starts 10 days before the date the application is received by MassHealth.</p>
<p>MassHealth CommonHealth</p>	<p>Coverage starts 10 days before the date the application is received by MassHealth.</p> <p>If applicant has a deductible <u>and</u> meets the deductible, then coverage starts the date that the deductible period began.</p>
<p>MassHealth Premium Assistance</p>	<p>Payment begins the month of the MassHealth eligibility decision or the month that the health insurance coverage begins, whichever is later.</p> <p>Each monthly premium assistance payment is for the coverage for the next month.</p>
<p>MassHealth Limited</p>	<p>Coverage starts 10 days before the date the application is received by MassHealth.</p>
